

REVIEW BODY ACTS TO PROTECT TEACHERS' PAY

REJECTED

proposal to allow schools to move teachers down from the upper pay range

REJECTED

proposals to extend pay flexibilities through 'grace and favour' payments

REJECTED

the Government's argument that 1% is enough for teachers

The Review Body said:

“ *Based on our assessment of recruitment and retention considerations alone, there is a case for an uplift higher than 1% to the national pay framework* **”**

Having been prevented from making a higher award, the Review Body **has recommended a minimum of 1%** across the board from September 2016, which it believes schools can afford.

The NASUWT will be responding to the consultation.
